*There are key points below that you need to understand and agree to **before** signing up:*

Participation Requirements:

- Students must be at the playing level that qualifies them to be in the CHBA Concert Band or higher.
- Trip Performers must participate in our 2024 Summer Band Program from May 20 to August 4, 2024. The tuition for Summer Band in 2024 is \$249 and is NOT included in the trip's price.
- Performers are required to be at all trip rehearsals listed below:

Monday, May 20th – 6:30 to 8:30 pm

Monday, June 10 – 6:30 to 8:30 pm

Monday, June 17 – 6:30 to 8:30 pm

Monday, June 24 – 6:30 to 8:30 pm

- Performers are ***strongly encouraged*** to participate in our Summer Camp from June 2 - 6, 2024; however, Summer Camp Participation is not required.
- Non-Member students are allowed to participate if they are recommended by CHBA staff or current CHBA members. They must adhere to the above-mentioned requirements, including full participation in our Summer Band Program.
